No man is ever truly himself. He does not have a single, fixed character or unchanging opinions and preferences. He lives through the others. He lives for them and against them. In adoration, love or hatred, but always connected. No one is ever alone, no matter how lonely he feels. We all live with others: some we dominate, some dominate us. The weaker submit to the stronger, the imitators to the originators, lovers to their beloved. Everything is constantly flowing, blending and changing: people's characters, opinions and paths. And all of this forms a single grand story reflecting our lack of independence.

People are products of their times. But who determines the spirit of the time? All those little people who are at once its passive victims and its co-conspirators, its co-creators.

This is a film about our time. About the darkness that is once again starting to embrace Europe. It is embodied by adults. But the film is also about the desire for freedom carried within their children.

#### DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Petr Vaclav graduated from Prague Film Academy FAMU. His short documentary MADAME LE MURIE (1993) was nominated for Student Academy Award.

Vaclav's first feature film, MARIAN (1996) - the story of a Romani child - won the Silver Leopard and the FIPRESCI Award in Locarno and other prizes at Angers, Thessaloniki, Belfort, Cottbus, Bratislava and Tehran film festivals, and had theatrical release in France, the Netherlands, the USA and South Korea. His second feature, PARALLEL WORLD, (2001) was selected for the San Sebastian Official Competition. His recent feature THE WAY OUT about a young Romani woman fighting for an ordinary life was screened at Cannes (ACID Selection 2014) and released in France under the name ZANETA.

Petr is currently finishing his latest feature SKOKAN. His documentary CONFESSION OF THE VANI-SHED, portraying Czech composer Josef Myslivecek (1734-1781) was released in April 2015 and is the part of the work on Vaclav's ambitious project, Il BOEMO.
